Vilhelm Moberg - Sweden's greatest writer



Vilhelm Moberg was born in 1898 in Småland, in the south of Sweden. He was the fourth child in a family of seven kids. He led a harsh and simple childhood, and early on found an interest in the literary world. With works such as *Ride this night*,

When I was a child and perhaps foremost the amazing *Emigrant saga* Moberg has clearly positioned himself as Sweden's greatest writer.

Not only was he one of Sweden's most successful writers, his plays were very successful all throughout Sweden. Even up to this day one can look at the musical *Kristina from Duvemåla* (set up by Björn and Benny of ABBA) to see his long lasting influence on the Swedish cultural life.

In 1973 he drowned in a lake in Roslagen, north of Stockholm, in what apparently was a suicide.
